Prof. Neelesh Kumar Jain is a distinguished academic in manufacturing science and engineering. He joined IIT Indore in 2010 as an Associate Professor, became a full Professor in 2013, and has since played an instrumental role in the institution's development. His education includes a PhD and MTech from IIT Kanpur and a BE in Mechanical Engineering from SGSITS Indore. Prof. Jain's research focuses on advanced manufacturing processes, including hybrid machining, additive manufacturing, gear finishing, and micro-joining. Notable contributions include the development of electrochemical honing (ECH) and micro-plasma transferred arc (μ -PTA) processes for cost-effective, high-precision finishing and additive manufacturing. He has also pioneered the use of WEDM for high-quality meso-sized gear production and abrasive flow finishing (AFF) for spur and bevel gears. At IIT Indore, he established five state-of-the-art research labs and the DST-FIST Center of Excellence in Gear Engineering. Prof. Jain has held several key administrative roles, including Acting Director and the inaugural Dean of Academic Affairs, where he significantly shaped the academic framework and curriculum. His leadership and vision have greatly contributed to IIT Indore's growth as a leading research institution.
